Pregnant Students

The Board recognizes that every student should have access to a free and public education regardless of her physical condition and reaffirm that pregnant students are eligible for regular or special education services provided by the District under the following conditions:

- 1. The individual shall be examined by a physician licensed by a State Board of Medical Examiners verifying the condition of pregnancy.
- 2. When home instruction is provided, individualized goals and objectives shall be compatible with those developed in the regular classroom.
- 3. Teachers of individuals receiving home instruction shall hold appropriate certification.
- 4. Individuals who are pregnant will not be prevented from choosing to continue to attend classes in the regular school program.
- 5. Pregnant students and their parents shall be informed of rights to special educational services.
- 6. Counseling will be facilitated as a related service.
- 7. Pregnant students and their parents will be informed as to the availability of resources provided by other agencies.
- 8. A pregnant student will be allowed to participate in all school-sponsored activities as long as her physical and emotional condition permit.
